### Fringe Rush Tix

You heard it here first! Fringe Rush Tix are back for 2018! Available 12 - 2pm weekdays during the Fringe and only in person from the Box Office.

Fringe Rush Tix are limited special deals, heavily discounted, and 2-4-1's tickets.

### Koha\* Shows

Here at Fringe, we are super into KOHA and FREE stuff - 25% of the programme is free or koha.

Koha is a New Zealand Māori custom which can be translated as gift, present, offering, donation or contribution.

Many koha shows have very limited capacity. You can save a seat to koha shows for a reservation fee of \$5 and then add koha at the performance. Or you can just turn up and risk it, also a valid option.

Koha in the Fringe usually means you are experiencing an event that is; development work, expressing new formats, ideas or work, or, work an artist specifically wants to be as accessible as possible.

### Concessions

Concession rates apply to Community Service Card holders, Gold Card holders, Students with ID, and young adults (under 16) and children. Fringe also offers concession rates to care companions. Proof of concession eligibility is required at point of sale or when entering venues.

### No Booking Fees for 2018

Fringe isn't charging booking fees in 2018 however all credit card purchases will incur a processing fee at the end of your transaction.
